NEW BAUXITE PROJECTS /WITHDRAWAL FROM FONGO TONGO

Fongo Tongo Bauxite Project in Cameroon

Whinnen Resources Ltd ("Whinnen") has decided not to proceed with the Fongo Tongo Bauxite Project in Cameroon and has informed the various parties involved. Further evaluation of the Project had revealed issues that were not satisfactory to Whinnen.

New Western Australian Applications

The Board of Whinnen has decided to continue to assess bauxite as well as other resources opportunities. To this end, Whinnen has applied for three exploration licences on the eastern Darling Plateau of Western Australia. The licences are located near Walebing (ELA70/3448), Bolgart (ELA70/3447) and Popanyinning (ELA70/3450). The exploration licences were applied for due to the presence of good laterite and alumina values of up to 42.8% Al₂O₃ at Bolgart and 33.7% Al₂O₃ at Popanyinning recorded by the Geological Survey of Western Australia. These random samples compare well with the average ore grade of 31% at Alcoa and Worsley's bauxite mines on the Darling Plateau. Impurities such as reactive silica are yet to be determined.

All of the exploration licence applications are located near railways, and have good electricity and water infrastructure.

Whinnen plans to fully explore these new applications for bauxite mineralisation as soon as they are granted.
